The above is a clear example of the unstructured management of data which, thanks to Generative AI, can generate content and convert them into valuable knowledge for the organization. In this case, the development has resulted in savings amounting to 75%-90% in unit costs, thanks to the automation of the information classification and extraction processes, as well as a tenfold reduction in the time spent on each document, which has fallen from minutes with the manual method to a matter of seconds. Moreover, the project, developed in the AWS cloud, demonstrates the potential of Generative AI to transform traditional sectors and open up new business opportunities.
